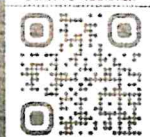

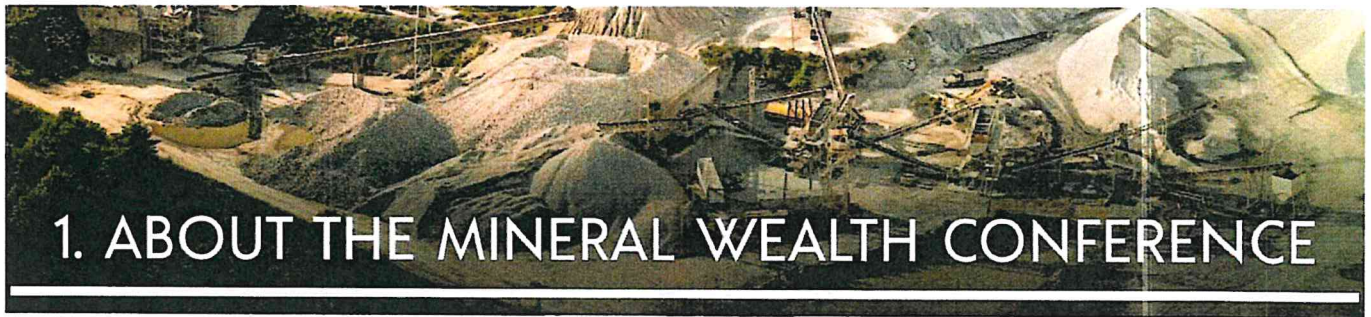

2. THEME & RATIONALE

" Beneath the Surface: Unlocking Africa's Next Mining Powerhouse "

Uganda sits atop one of Africa's most geologically blessed terrains. From world-class Rare Earth Elements at Makuutu, to gold fields stretching across Buhweju, iron ore deposits in Kabale, phosphates in Tororo, graphite at Orom, and a newly complete aerial geophysical map revealing fresh frontiers — the country is not short of resources. What it needs now is the bold, coordinated ambition to turn geological promise into generational prosperity.

The theme "Minerals to Millions" captures this decisive moment: moving beyond exploration and policy discourse into the terrain of deals, production, value addition, and measurable economic transformation. It challenges every stakeholder — government, investor, financier, community, and innovator — to ask not just what Uganda has, but what Uganda is doing with it.

Key Questions the Conference Will Address:

- How do we accelerate the conversion of Uganda's verified mineral reserves into operating mines and processing facilities?
- What financing innovations can de-risk and fast-track mining investment in Uganda's frontier deposits?
- How does Uganda leverage critical minerals diplomacy to position itself in global clean energy supply chains?
- What role do local communities and artisanal miners play in the value addition ecosystem?

Uganda's geological endowment spans over fifty-eight categories of minerals — metallic, industrial, and energy minerals — distributed across its geological formations. High-resolution aeromagnetic surveys have now mapped the entire country, revealed high-potential anomaly zones, and confirmed world-class deposit potential in previously unexplored regions.
